

HOW YOU CAN HELP MAKE A DIFFERENCE

1. Write to your Member of Parliament urging them to support Bill C-268.

If you are unsure who your MP is, you can enter your postal code on the website of the Parliament of Canada. <http://www.parl.gc.ca/common/index.asp>

Remember all mail to a Member of Parliament does not require any postage. You can address letters using the following example:

2. Write to the Justice Minister of Canada to voice your support of Bill C-268.

4. Write a letter to the editor of your local paper or a national paper about human trafficking and Bill C-268.
